Note: TEXCAP guidelines are not guidelines to determine a clients eligibility to receive food assistance. These guidelines are to determine a client's eligibility to receive the USDA Commodities that may be in your food pantry.

Exceptions that will qualify a client for USDA Commodities:

- ◆ Farmers and self-employed households qualify based on net income (Total income minus expenses).
- ◆ A household with unexpected and unavoidable expenses of a household crisis may qualify for temporary, emergency food assistance without regard to the household's gross or net income.
